The class meets at OHSU on Mondays during Spring semester (beginning February 7, 2011) from 4:30-6:30 pm for a lecture series and to learn about ongoing research projects conducted by OHSU scientist mentors. Each student will be paired with a mentor. Students in the program gain first-hand knowledge of research methods, and, with their mentors' help, present published research articles in journal club format and write their own research proposals. The course requires regular attendance and significant time commitment outside of class for homework and research proposal development. Students may elect to do laboratory research with their mentors over the summer. Students are also encouraged to develop a science fair project with the assistance of their mentor. High school freshmen, sophomores and juniors are eligible to apply.
